THE VIRGIN BIRTH

Matthew 1:18-25

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: when His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child by the Holy Spirit. (Mt. 1:18)

Take time to read and pray through the passage and other scripture mentioned during the sermon.

- 3. How does Joseph, carefully considering his situation with Mary, provide us an example of how to handle difficult situations?
- 4. In what ways can you care for your relationship with Jesus?
